The school day begins at 9:00 A.M. and ends at 2:00 P.M. How many hours is the school day?

The play began at 10.30 A.M. and ended at 12:15 P.M. How many hours and minutes long was the play?

The show began at 11:15 A.M. The show ended 1 hour and 45 minutes after it began. What time did the show end?
