

Answer to test question 19I: The parallel lines are (a). The intersecting lines are (b). The perpendicular lines are (a).


**Parallel lines** – Lines that stay the same distance apart.



Read – line CD is parallel to line PQ.


Write − 
$$\overrightarrow{CD} \parallel \overrightarrow{PQ}$$

**Intersecting lines** – Lines that meet or cross each other. They meet at exactly one point.



Read – line CD intersects line PQ.


**Perpendicular lines** – Intersecting lines that form four right angles.



**Read** – Line *CD* is perpendicular to line *PQ*.

Write – 
$$\overrightarrow{CD} \perp \overrightarrow{PQ}$$


