Example

Jack has 275 marbles. He put an equal number of marbles in 6 bags. There were some marbles remaining. How many marbles were left?

Answer: $275 \div 6 = 45 \text{ r}5$

2. Mark is putting apples in boxes. He has 259 apples. Each box holds 8 apples. How many boxes does he need? How many apples are in the box that is not full?
